## Job description

The development worker (m/w/d) will advise and provide support to the regional health authority (DRSP) in the implementation of the national data collection system as well as in the coordination of the partners' contributions, particularly in the field of reproductive health. The development worker (m/w) contributes to capacity building and provides advice in quality management of data collection in selected pilot districts. The development worker (m/w/d) promotes harmonization and collaboration among the stakeholders in the West Region and maintains close contact

with the colleagues in Yaoundé and South West region. This intervention aims to improve the data situation and to guarantee the data quality, particularly reproductive health-related data.

- Harmonization of the data tools with reproductive health indicators of the regional level
- Support the coordination and collaboration among stakeholders, as well as the promotion of networking between multi- and bilateral partners at the regional level
- Close collaboration with the central level and the Southwest Region to improve data completeness, availability and quality
- Support of the data analysis through the use of electronic database DHIS2

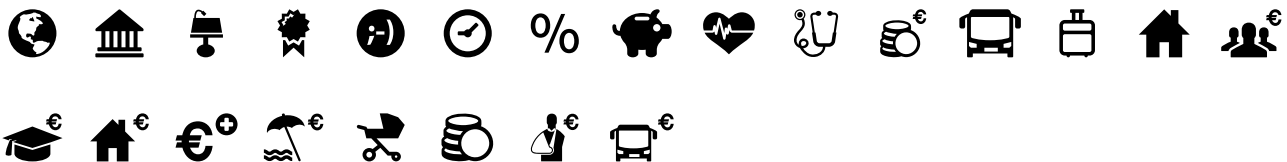
